

## **Corps of Engineer's Work Plan Released for FY 2022 Civil Works Projects**

NUCA members will find a heads-up on future bid opportunities in your region in the just-delivered U.S. Army Corps of Engineers report to Congress on their Fiscal Year 2022 Work Plan.

\$6.8 billion was allocated by the March 15, 2022 FY 2022 appropriations act for specific programs, plans, and activities performed by the Corps as part of its Army Civil Works program. The specific allocation of these funds is presented in its Work Plan to Congress.

The Army Civil Works program funds the planning, design, construction, and operation and maintenance of water resources projects. It focuses on the highest performing work within the three main Civil Works mission areas: commercial navigation, flood and storm damage reduction, and aquatic ecosystem restoration.

With the total funding for FY 2022, the Work Plan funds to completion 18 feasibility studies, 14 projects in the preconstruction engineering and design phase, and 7 construction projects or elements of projects. The act also provides funding for a limited number of new studies and new projects, including 21 previously unfunded projects within their investigations account and 5 within their construction account.
