Montana Construction Company Wins National Construction Safety Award

(Fairfax, Va.) – A local Montana company has won one of the National Utility Contractors Association's (NUCA) William H. Feather Safety Awards for their commitment to safety on their jobsites.

Barnard Construction Company of Bozeman, Mont., will be presented with this coveted trophy at the association's annual convention being held Feb. 27-29 in Tucson, Arizona.

The NUCA-member company will be the winner of the 1,000,000+ Manhours Worked award category. The company's leadership was notified earlier this month that they will be presented with their winner's plaque at the convention's Gala Dinner on Saturday, Feb. 29.

The William H. Feather Safety Award was created in 1978 to commemorate the outstanding contributions of the founding chairman of NUCA's Safety Committee, William H. Feather, and to recognize the remarkable achievements in safety accomplished by NUCA members each year.

Feather Awards are bestowed upon companies that have the best safety records in seven categories according to total man-hours worked. Winners in each category are selected based on injury frequency data, a short safety management statement and company safety program information.
